


INTRODUCTION

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





Case Study with qualitative approach Triangulation of four diagnostic Methods


- Genogram with interview sequences

- Family board (project the inner notions of family relations in a simple order at a 50x50cm broad of wood with simple wooden stones/figures)





























CONCLUSION
